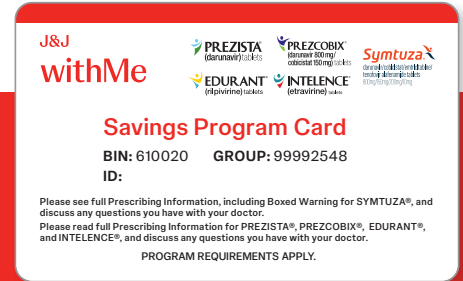


Cost Support Options

Commercial or private insurance? (Insurance issued by an employer)

Eligible patients pay **\$0 per fill**

Maximum program benefit per calendar year shall apply. Not valid for patients using Medicare, Medicaid, or other government-funded programs to pay for their medicines. Terms expire at the end of each calendar year. Offer subject to change or end without notice. Restrictions, including monthly maximums, may apply. Patient Assistance for Patients Facing Affordability Challenges
