

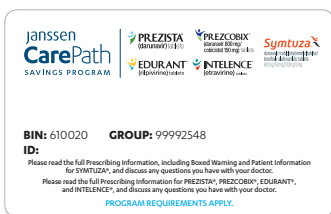
## Affordability Options for SYMTUZA®, PREZISTA®, PREZCOBIX®, EDURANT®, and INTELENCE®

### Eligible patients pay \$0 per fill

\$12,500 maximum program benefit per calendar year for SYMTUZA®. \$7,500 maximum program benefit per calendar year for PREZISTA®, PREZCOBIX®, EDURANT®, and INTELENCE®. Not valid for patients using Medicare, Medicaid, or other government-funded programs to pay for their medications. Terms expire at the end of each calendar year and may change.
